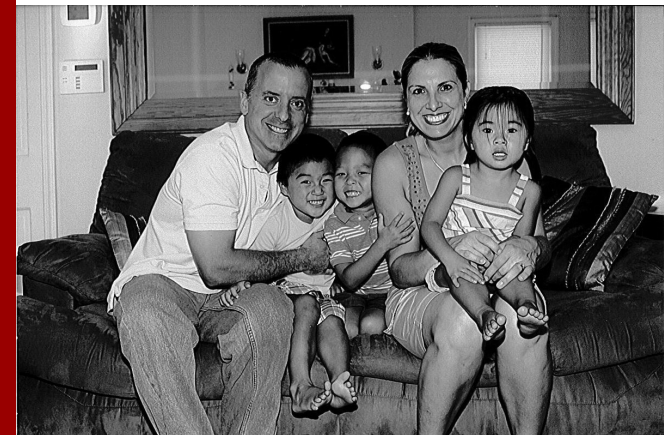

- Post-placement & post-adoption supervision



Family Directions works to find permanent families for children who cannot be cared for by their biological parents & to assist couples & singles who choose to become parents through adoption. Adoption services are organized to provide a coordinated set of services for the child, the child's biological parents, & adoptive parents.
