Please make an appointment to visit the Danbury Housing Hub, our local drop-in center. You do not need an appointment if you visit during walk-in hours, Monday/Tuesday/Thursday, 10am–3pm. Any language can be accommodated.

WHO WE HELP

You can come to the Danbury Housing Hub (managed by Catholic Charities of Fairfield County) if you are:

- Homeless right now, or
- Will be homeless within the next 14 days

If you do not meet these criteria but still need help, please contact the organizations listed at the bottom of this flyer.

WHAT WE DO

Trained professionals at the Danbury Housing Hub can help you:

- Explore potential housing and emergency shelter options. PLEASE NOTE: Shelter might not be immediately available.
- Connect you with local food pantries and soup kitchens
- Connect you with other local support services and agencies
